If your child is ever lost, missing or abducted, call your local police department immediately. It is imperative that you report your child as missing within the first 30 minutes

that you realize your child

Follow my safety rules for your protection that you realize your child is gone. *Time is the enemy.*

The longer you wait to report your child missing, the more time the abductor has to get your child further away from you.

You then need to report your child missing to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children at

1-800-THE LOST.
